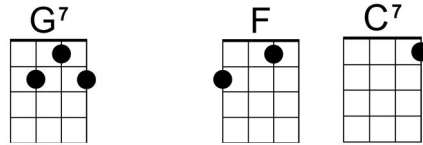


# ON A COCONUT ISLAND

**Strum C7 once and let it ring!**
