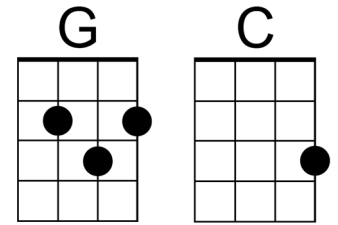
$\frac{3}{4}$ Time/Waltz time: D dudu. Emphasize the first Down

[G] When troubles surround us, when evils [C] come,

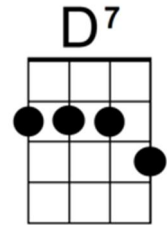
The body grows [D7] weak (body grows weak),
